PRINT COMPETITION

Guidelines for presentation of prints

• All prints must be mounted on board cut to the following size

500mm x 400mm

- Prints can be presented as portrait or landscape.
- The actual size of print is not defined but the author must take into account the viewing situation in a competition.
- If you surface-mount prints, please ensure there is are no glue deposits which could damage other prints.
- Window mounted prints must have a backing sheet on the back of the print. This will protect other prints from damage caused by tape etc.
- The title of the print must be clear on the back. It helps if the title is put at the top so as to make clear the viewing position.
- Please ensure that your finished, mounted print can not cause damage to any other prints when they are in a pile together.
- Prints may not be displayed in any kind of plastic cover. Such covers increase reflections and make it difficult for the judge and members to properly see the print.
- Any print that does not reach the above standard will not be included in the competition.
- The person presenting prints to the judge has the right to refuse inclusion of a print in line with the above.
- In case of dispute the club president will have the final say.
